Pomona College since 2001 (assistant to full professor), with stints at the University of California, Santa Barbara between 2002-2006 (tenure-track, returned to Pomona College after four years away), at the National University of Singapore in 2009 (senior visiting scholar), at the University of California, Berkeley in 2012 (senior visiting scholar), and at the National University of Economics and Social Sciences (distinguished visiting professor) in Beijing in 2013, 2015, 2016, and 2017. I also hold various positions as a distinguished consultant in Prague, Budapest, Ho Chi Minh City, and Aix-en-Provence.

35+ grants and fellowships (examples include Haynes Foundation, Freeman Foundation, Social Science Research Council, Hewlett Foundation, etc.). An award was given to me in 2012 by the American Sociological Association for excellence in teaching and mentorship. *Insufficient Funds* won two major book awards: Best 2015 Book on Asia from the American Sociological Association and Best 2016 Book in the Social Sciences from the Association for Asian American Studies.

Former students have won many prestigious awards (Fulbright, Ford, NSF, and such); they have been admitted to all of the top ten PhD programs and law schools, and are working in all of the professions (notably the academy and law).
